



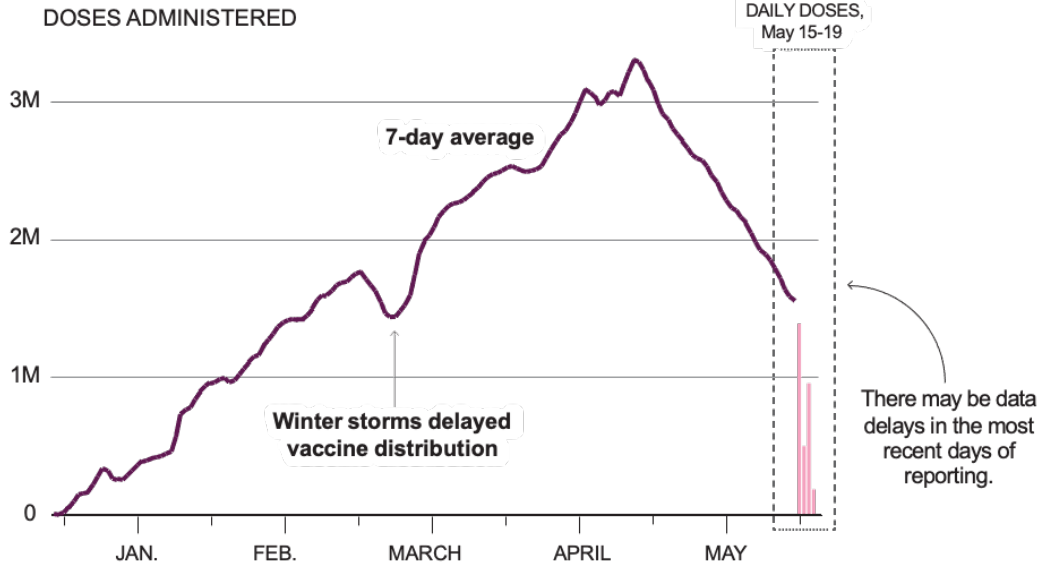

Vaccine tracker: 60.2% of U.S. adults have received first dose

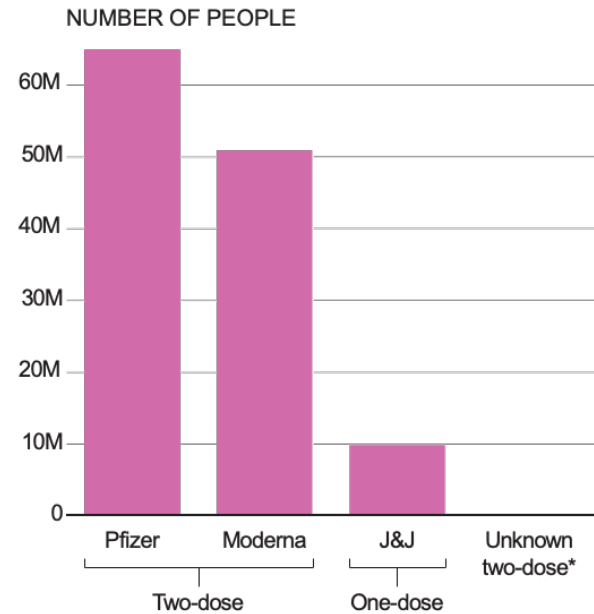
As of May 19, CDC data shows 60.2% of American adults have received at least one Covid-19 vaccine dose, and 47.9% have been fully vaccinated.

Vaccination rates are higher for the 65-and-older group: 84.7% of older adults have received at least one dose, and 73% are fully vaccinated. The Biden administration announced this week that, in addition to the 60 million AstraZeneca doses the U.S. will be sending to countries in need, an additional 20 million doses (from Pfizer, Moderna, or Johnson & Johnson) will be sent across the world by the end of June.
