


Covid-19 rate fell in just one county In October

Covid-19 case rates grew in all but a few counties across the U.S. from October to November, a POLITICO analysis of data shows. The data, compiled by Johns Hopkins University, shows Covid-19 case rates per 100,000 people in each county. The rate of cases in Yakutat borough, Alaska (the state is organized into boroughs instead of counties), fell 66% from Oct. 1 to Nov. 1 — though it is only home to about 600 people. Cases in Los Angeles County, the largest county in the country by population, grew 2.3% over the same period, from 14,550 cases to 14,883 cases per 100,000.
