



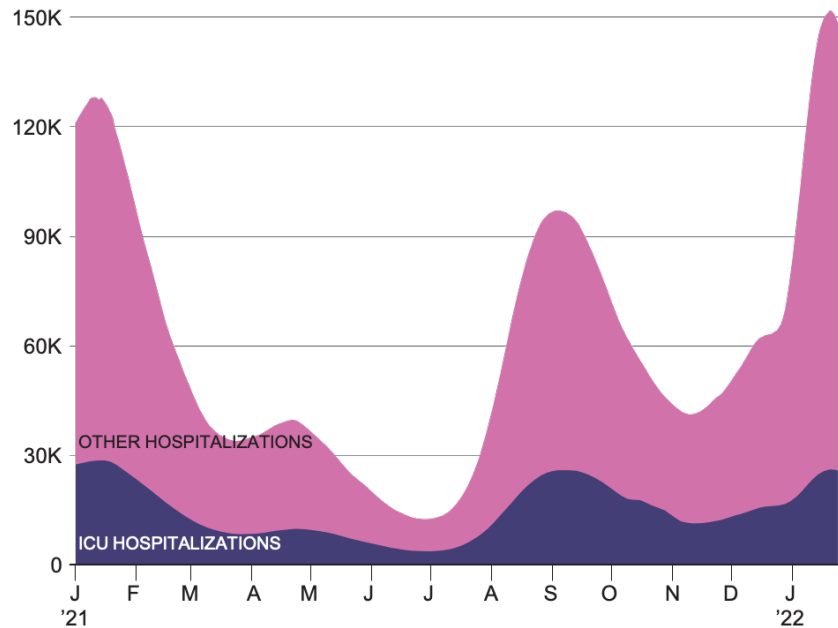

Covid-19 tracker: Biden vaccine standard withdrawn; proposed rule remains

The Department of Labor is withdrawing its emergency temporary standard that created a large-employer vaccine mandate after the ETS was blocked by the Supreme Court. However, the department is still pursuing the same standard as a proposed rule, and OSHA has said it is still working on Covid-19 workplace safety regulations.

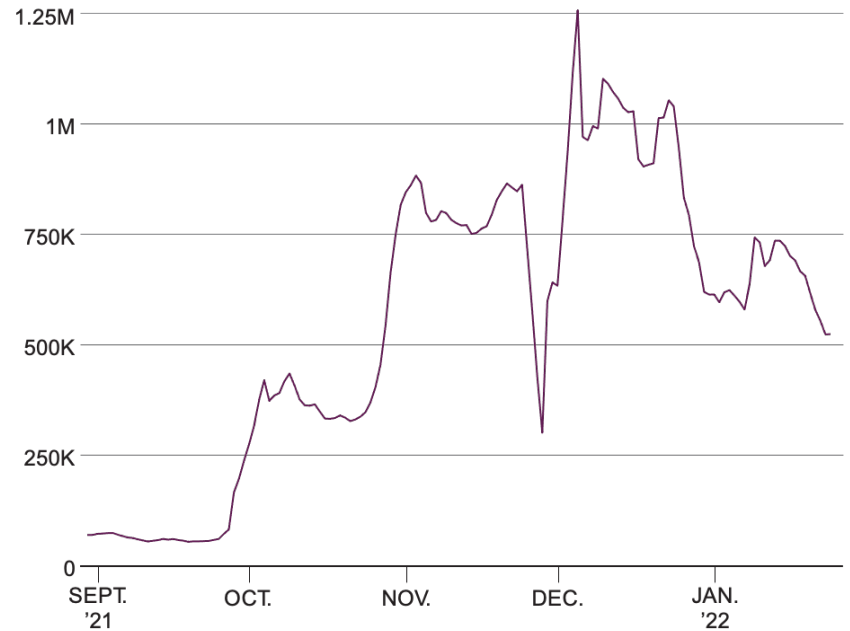
Covid-19 hospitalizations at highest level yet

New booster doses fall off as January draws to close
