



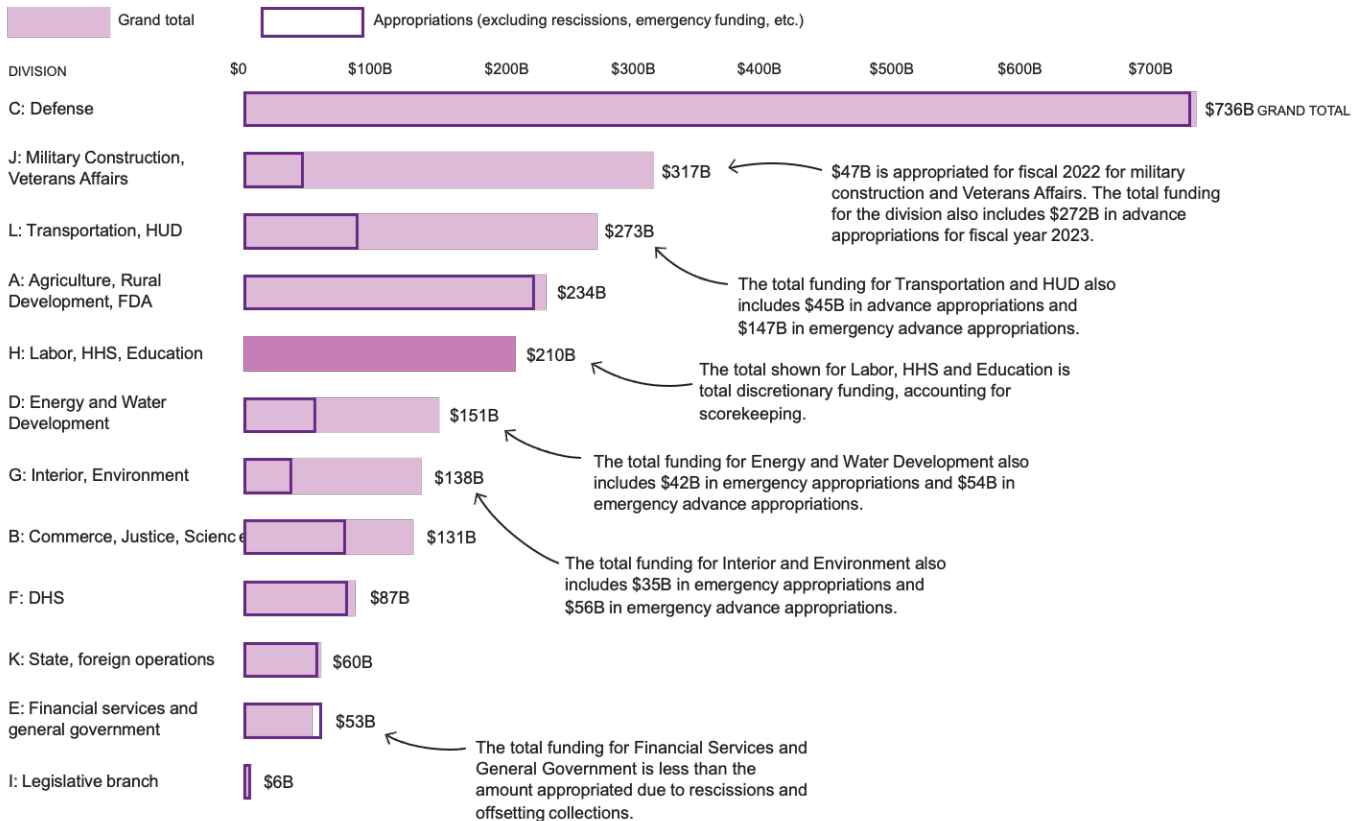

## Omnibus provides \$1.5T in funding for fiscal 2022

House Democratic leaders on March 9 released a bill to fund the government through the end of fiscal year 2022. The funding package is attached to an unrelated bill, H.R. 2471, and comprises all 12 appropriations titles in a \$1.5 trillion spending package. The package also includes almost \$14 billion in aid for Ukraine.

The difference between "Grand total" and "appropriations" is due to inclusion of several other types of funding, including, for each division: **Division A: Agriculture, Rural Development, FDA:** emergency appropriations, emergency advance appropriations, offsetting collections and rescissions; **Division B: Commerce, Justice, Science:** rescissions, emergency appropriations and emergency advance appropriations; **Division C: Defense:** emergency appropriations and rescissions; **Division D: Energy and Water Development:** emergency appropriations, emergency advance appropriations, rescissions and emergency offsetting collections (FY2025-2026); **Division E: Financial services and general government:** rescissions, emergency appropriations, emergency advance appropriations, rescissions of emergency funding, offsetting collections and disaster relief category; **Division F: DHS:** defense and non-defense rescissions, offsetting collections, emergency appropriations, emergency advance appropriations and mandatory funding; **Division G: Interior, Environment:** rescissions, advance appropriations, emergency appropriations, emergency advance appropriations, offsetting collections and fire suppression cap adjustment; **Division J: Military Construction, Veterans Affairs:** rescissions and FY23 advance appropriations; **Division K: State, foreign operations:** emergency appropriations and rescissions; and **Division L: Transportation, HUD:** rescissions, emergency appropriations, advance appropriations, emergency advance appropriations, offsetting receipts and offsetting collections
