


Solar shipments remain strong despite impediments

By September, 14.5 gigawatts of solar panel shipments to the U.S. had already outpaced 2019's yearly total of 13.2 GW. Although solar shipments are robust, they have had to contend with several setbacks: supply chain uncertainty associated with the coronavirus pandemic, changes in state policies regarding net metering, a decline in state-level incentives and steep tariffs imposed by the Trump administration in 2018.

The solar industry has called on President-elect Joe Biden and Congress to remove barriers and add incentives for solar development.
