


U.S. additions to wind power capacity in Q4 of 2020 set record

February 9, 2021

The American wind power industry added a record 10.6 gigawatts of new capacity during the last three months of 2020, enough to power about 3 million homes. As of Jan. 1, 2021, more than 60,000 wind turbines in 41 states and two U.S. territories had a capacity of 122 gigawatts of wind energy, with another 35 gigawatts still in development.
