



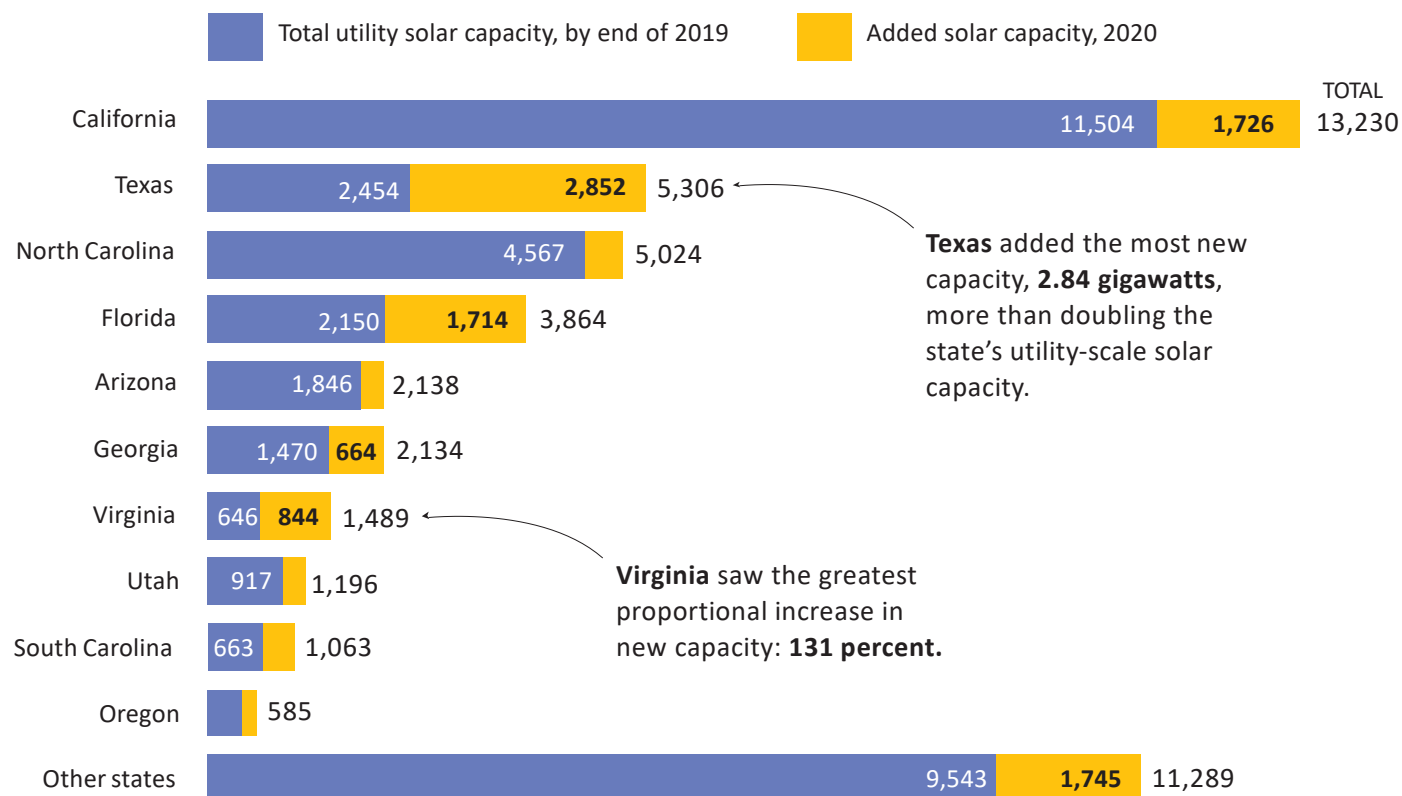

2020 sets record with new utility-scale solar installations

American utilities added a record 11.2 gigawatts of solar capacity in 2020, a 31 percent increase in total capacity and more than twice the capacity added in 2019. The U.S. now has more than 47 gigawatts of utility-scale solar capacity, enough to power 11 million homes, or about 8 percent of households.
