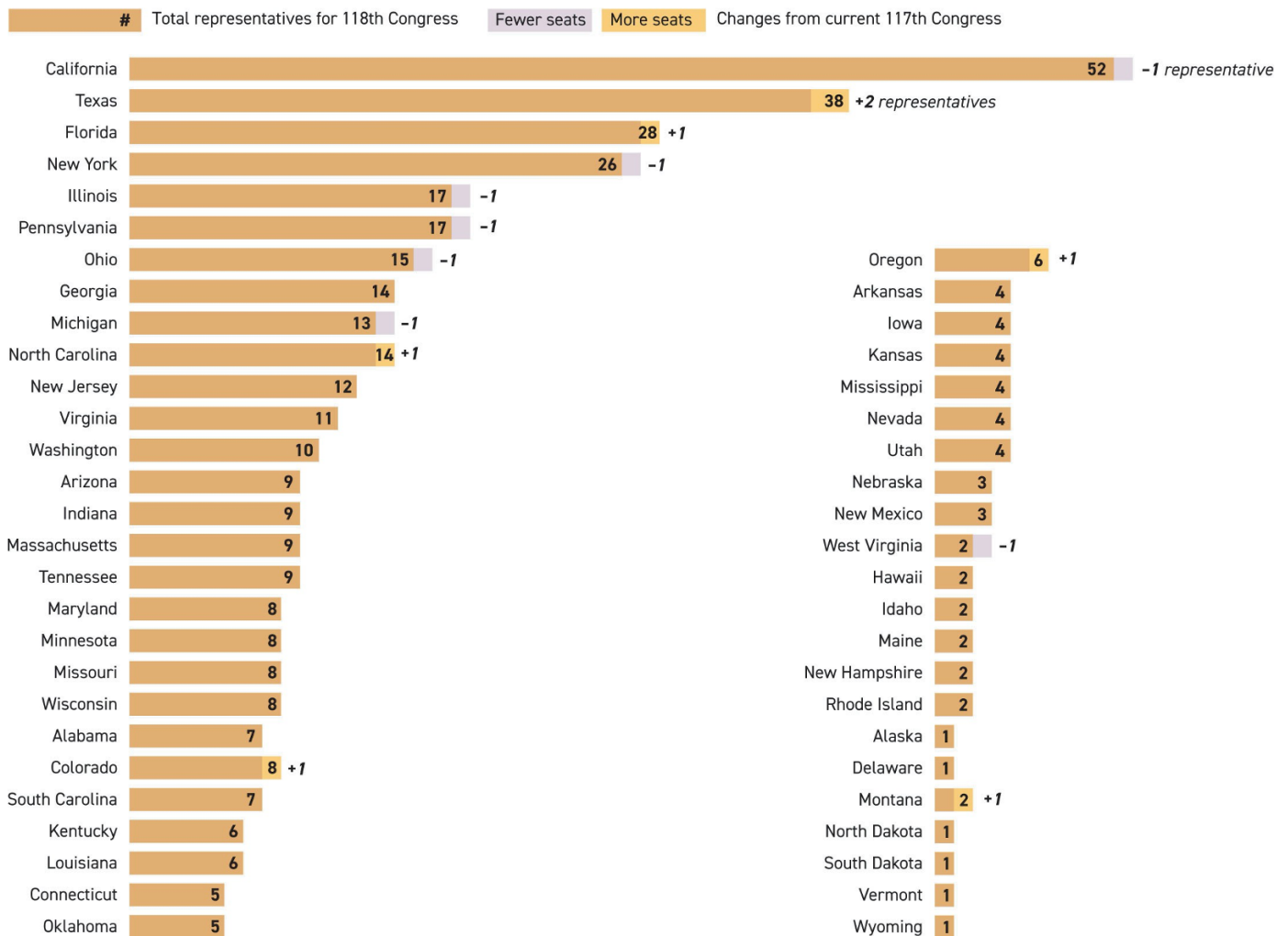

2020 reapportionment: Power shifts slightly to South and West

The Census Bureau has adjusted the number of House representatives in 13 states, based on data from the 2020 census. Shifts over the past decade have seen greater portions of the population moving to the South and West. Seven states lost one seat, five states gained one seat and Texas gained two seats. In late summer/early fall, the Census Bureau will release finer-detailed population data, which will be used by states for redistricting.
