

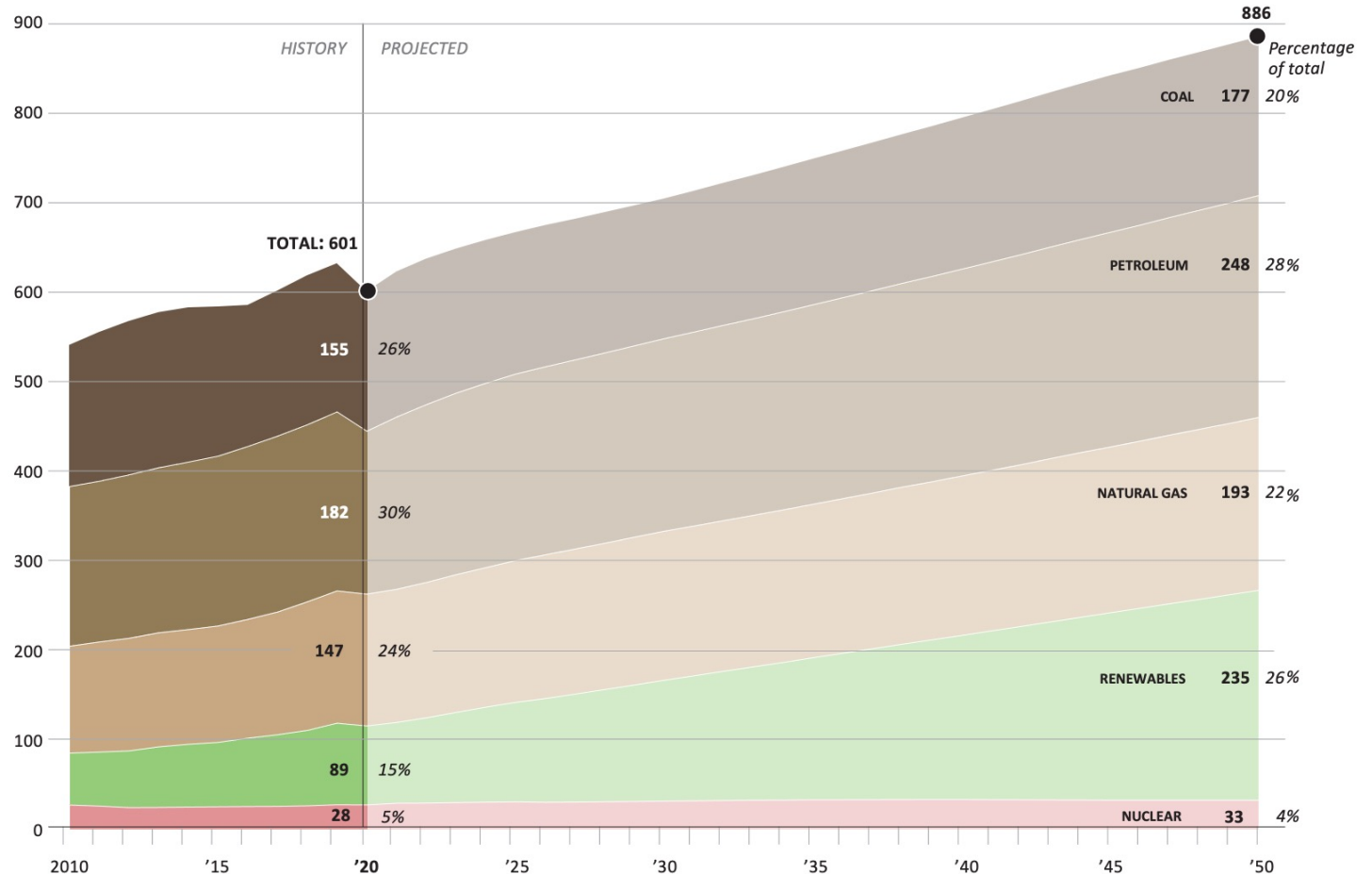


# Despite growth of renewables, world energy demand is forecast to drive increased consumption of fossil fuels

The rapid growth of renewable energy will not be enough to even satisfy new demands for energy, according to projections by the Energy Information Administration. Unless major efforts shift the way the world sates its energy thirst, greenhouse gas emissions from fossil fuels will continue to increase, mostly in developing Asian countries.
